Refund Policy

Once a student has been accepted by the school and paid tuition fees in full, there will be no refund except under the following conditions:

If a student is unable to obtain a valid Canadian visa or passport to enter Canada, the said student will receive a full refund of the tuition fees minus the application fee of \$200.00.

In order to be eligible for a refund, the student must provide the following:

- 1) A letter in writing requesting a refund, signed by the student.
- 2) Proof of visa rejection issued by the Canadian Embassy or High Commission.
- 3) All the original documents, including any receipts issued by the school.

If a student is granted a Canadian visa and decides not to study at our school, they will not be eligible for a refund after day 10 of the account issue date, under any circumstance.

There will be no refund under any conditions if the student's visa application is refused, and he/she does not apply for a refund within 8 months of the admission date.
