Why are bees important?

Bees provide pollination to hundreds of plant species. This is really important not only for natural ecosystems, but also for human survival as 84% of the food we eat is reliant on pollination. Bees provide what would cost 57 billion dollars for humans to do.

What is the issue?

Due to human influences the bee population has faced significant struggles. Close to 35% of the worlds pollinators face extinction, which has a remarkable impact on agriculture and world ecosystems.
