




SOCIAL SERVICE WORKER - GERONTOLOGY

A **College Diploma in Social Service Worker - Gerontology** will qualify candidates for a wide range of positions across a broad spectrum of for-profit facilities, such as retirement homes, and not-for-profit agencies and facilities such as long-term care facilities, group homes, and community agencies providing services to older adults living in the community such as adult day programs. It also includes Government agencies, co-ordination of home support services, supportive housing co-ordination, co-ordination of volunteer programs, and therapeutic recreation/activation.




COMPUTER SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN - NETWORKING

As a way to bring further awareness and destigmatize mental health as a whole, Mental Health Services will take part in hosting a "Health and Wellness Week", starting the first week of August.



AceWalk supports all Ace Acumen community members who may feel unsafe or uncomfortable walking across campus or to nearby public transit zones alone.


Volunteers work alongside campus security to provide accompaniment services to Ace Acumen community members who may feel unsafe walking across campus alone.




