Winter Prep: A Guide for Facing the Cold

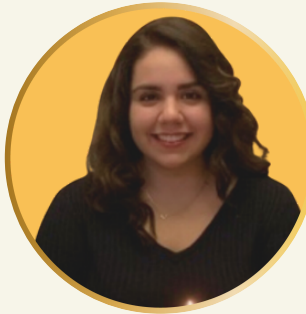


With the weather becoming colder we want to remind our students to dress appropriately for the winter. We encourage students to use the following infographic as a guide for how to dress during cold weather.

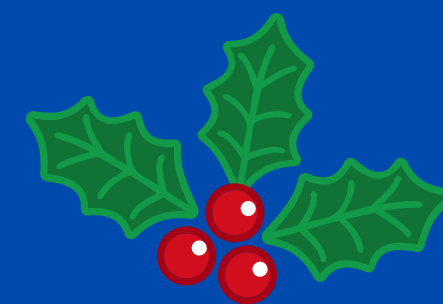

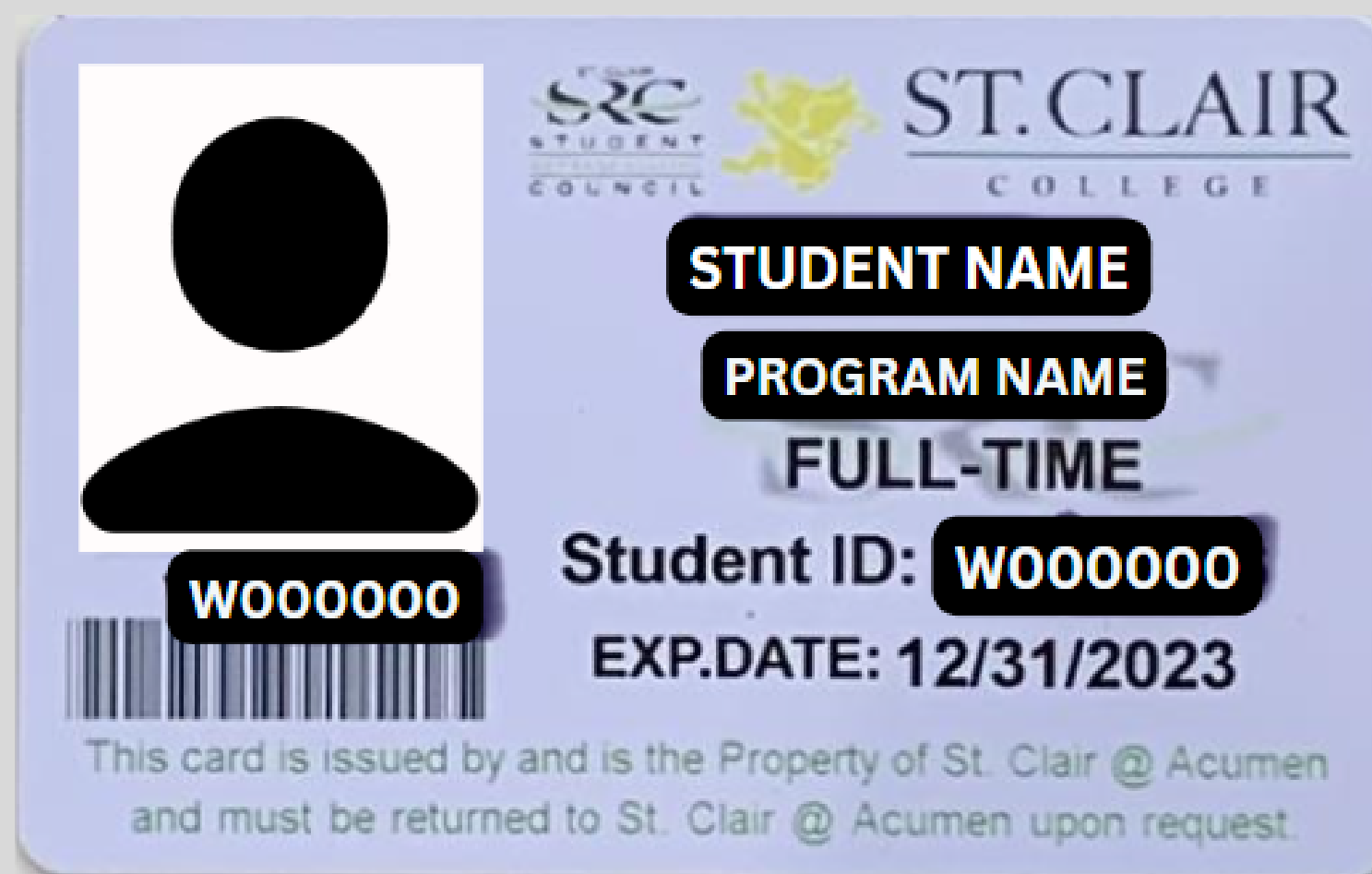

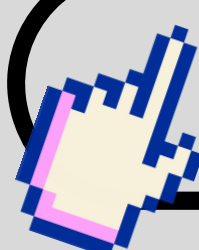
LinkedIn Search Tips: Finding Your Network

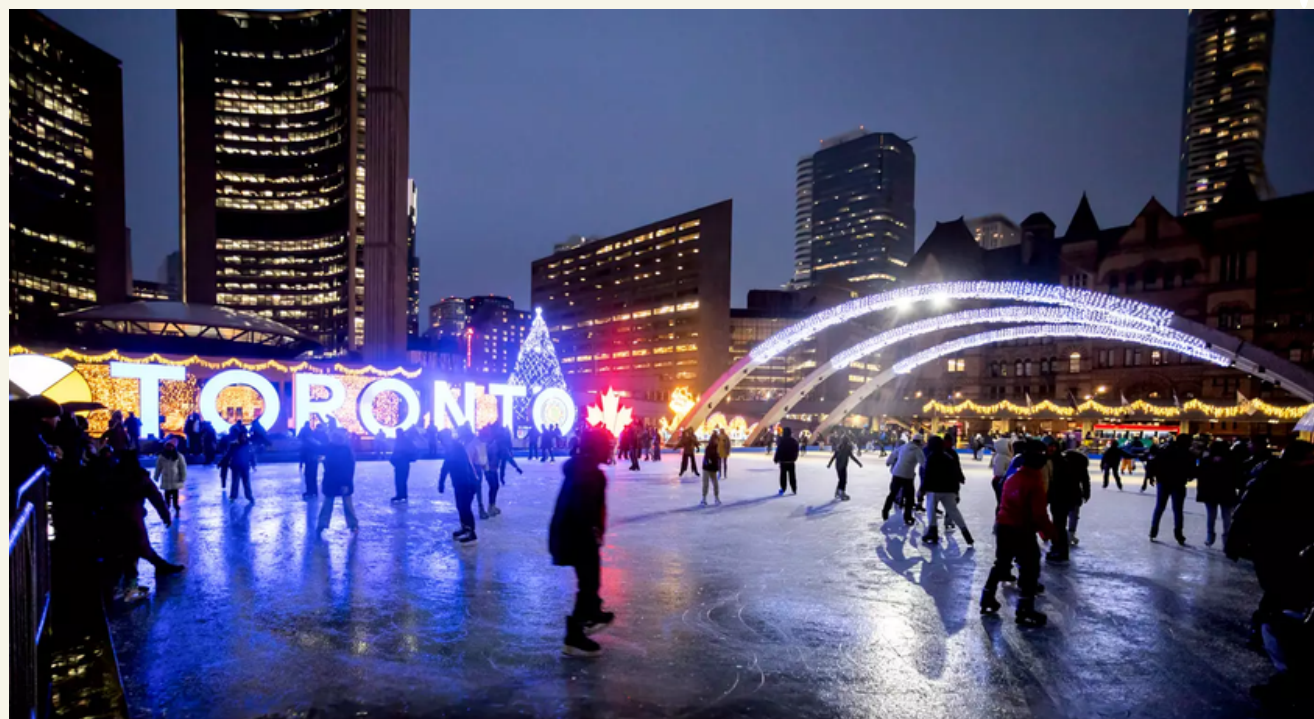
